



ALGARVIAN INVITATIONAL2026

6th January 2026 until 10th January 2026

Quinta da Cima & Quinta Do Vale

1. Conditions of Play:

- (i) The Algarvian Invitational for 2026 will be a 54 holes Stroke play event with 18 holes to be played each day. There will be no cut. Amateurs will compete in Stableford gross format.
- (ii) The Championship will have a maximum field of 120 players. The organizers reserve the right to increase the field.
- (iii) In the event of a tie for first place in the pros, there will be a sudden death play-off at Quinta da Cima immediately after play on the Final day.
- (iv) Starting times will be from 8.00am each day, as a 1 tee start except for the final round where there will be a two-tee start (1st and 10th) from 8.00am.
- (v) Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf of R&A Rules Ltd; Competition Local Rules and the additional Local Rules of the Quinta da Cima & Quinta do Vale Courses as approved by the Tournament Committee.
The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final.

Prize presentation will be made straight after play at Quinta da Cima on the 10th of January 2026 at Quinta da Cima Clubhouse.

2. Entrance Fees & Cancelation policy

- All entry fees including hotel accommodation fees must be paid by 15th November in full to secure entry.
- Any changes or cancelation after 15th November 2025 will have a charge of 50% from the full value due.
- Any Changes or cancelations after 15th December 2025 will be charged in full.
- Entries will be accepted after 15th November, however solely based on availability.

3. Registration for the Algarvian Invitational

Registration for The Algarvian Invitational must be made on the 6th January 2026 at the Tournament office located at the Quinta da Cima.

Alternatively, you may register by telephone until 3pm on the 6th January by calling the registration office on +351 932787806.

The draw for the 1st and 2nd Rounds will be made at 3pm on the 6th of January 2026 and posted at both golf courses, The Prime Energize & The Octant Praia Verde Hotel as well as the Senior Golf tour Europe website.

Players who have not registered by 3pm on 6th January 2026 in person, by email or phone call to registration office will not be included in the draws.

4. Entries

Entries may be accepted from Professionals who must be 48 years of age or older on Thursday 8th January 2026.

Entries may be accepted from Amateurs who must be 48 years of age or older on Thursday 8th January 2026 and will play a maximum playing handicap of 14 for men & 18 for ladies.

Current handicap certificates will be required from all amateurs upon registration at Quinta da Cima. Entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organizer

5. Prize Fund

A total Prize fund is estimated at €30.000 based on an entry of 120 players. 25% will be deducted from the total prize money for tax purposes.

1/3 of the professional field will receive prize money.

A list of the prize money breakdown will be posted with the draw for the 1st and 2nd Round from 8am on Wednesday 7th January 2026.

Amateur prizes will be gross and nett overall including daily prizes.

Pros within the Prize Fund will be paid by bank transfer and must have produced a document from their bank with their bank details to the organizer in order to receive their respective payment. IBAN & Swift/BICC code requested.

Caddies etc.

If you wish to reserve a caddie (€60 per round) or power caddie (€75 for 3 tournament days). For bookings and to make sure availability please e-mail algarvian.invitational@gmail.com Pull trolleys will be free.

Buggies

Buggies will be allowed for players over 70 years of age and during practice round to be paid directly at the golf courses.

Practise Rounds

The official practice day for the Championships will be on 6th January from 8.00-12.00 at Quinta da Cima and on 7th January at Quinta do Vale.
