Zala Springs Open 2019 - May 3-5

This event is played on the great Zala Springs golf resort in Hungary. Zala Springs is a 18 hole championship golf course. A unique golf experience is guaranteed by one of the world's finest course designers Robert Trent Jones, Jr. The 18 hole championship golf course is built surrounded natural reserves, vineyards and lakes, suitable to host all international tournaments both for professionals and amateurs. The course fits beautifully in the picturesque Zala Valley, around the course vineyards, rolling hills similar to the Tuscan countryside and lakes can be found. This is a 18 hole better ball event followed by a 36 hole individual event.

Rockliffe Hall Senior Open 2019 - May 20-21

After the event in Hungary, we are moving northwest and will for the first time have an SGTE event in UK. We are very happy to invite all senior golfers to the beautiful Rockliffe Hall golf resort.

Rockliffe Hall is a 18 hole championship golf course and is one of the most challenging in Europe. It is designed by Hawtree, the world-renowned course architect.

While its full 7,879 yards from the back tees will give even the best professional tour golfer a stern test, most will find the five individual tee boxes on each hole a welcome addition, offering players of all abilities the chance to experience the challenge. We will of course not play the course from the back tees, because we wish all players to enjoy the course and have a good time. This is a 36 hole individual event.
